




Experiencing God through

the text in Psalms 103:7


1. through God's works (deeds)
2. Through God's ways
(character)

37 The Israelites journeyed from Rameses to Succoth with about 600,000 men on foot, besides women and children. **38** And a **mixed multitude** also went up with them, along with great droves of livestock, both flocks and herds.

10 As Pharaoh approached, the Israelites looked up and saw the Egyptians marching after them, and they were **terrified** and cried out to the Lord. **11** They said to Moses, “Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us into the wilderness to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt?”


