National Association of Evangelicals describes evangelicals as those who focus "on the core convictions of the triune God, the Bible, faith, Jesus, salvation, evangelism, and discipleship."

Webster includes in its definition, "emphasizing salvation by faith in the atoning death of Jesus Christ through personal conversion, the authority of Scripture ...".

A radical disciple is someone who believes in Jesus and whose beliefs inform and transform their behavior. Discipleship goes beyond mere believing and puts feet to what one is learning about Jesus along the way... Radical discipleship is carrying out the commands of Jesus in every way possible. As the scripture says,

"Growing in every way to become more and more like Christ, who is the head of the church."
