
## Blueprint for Building God's Church

1 Corinthians 3:1-15

### Why must we attend church regularly?

- 1. He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, <u>as</u> was his custom. He stood up to read (<u>Luke 4:16</u>)
- 2. For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people." Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate...And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty." (2 Corinthians 16:18)
- 3. <u>not giving up meeting together</u>, as **some are in the habit of doing**, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching (<u>Hebrews 10:25</u>)
- 4. Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but rather in speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity, **show yourself an example** of those who believe. (1 Timothy 4: 12)





### Mature, spiritual people

<sup>10</sup>For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad.

2 Corinthians 5:10

If the work that anyone has built on the foundation survives, he will receive a reward.
