### Issues facing different churches


- **Ephesus**: The church that had <u>abandoned its first love</u> for Christ (2:4).
- Smyrna: The church that would <u>face severe persecution</u> (2:10).
- **Pergamum:** The church that <u>needed to repent of sin</u> (2:16).
- Thyatira: The church whose <u>false prophetess was</u> <u>leading people astray</u> (2:20).
- Sardis: The <u>sleeping church</u> that needed to wake up (3:2).
- Philadelphia: The church that had <u>patiently persevered</u> (3:10).
- Laodicea: The church with <u>lukewarm faith</u> (3:16).


### **Church belongs to Christ**
