Announcement from FEC Consistory:

We thank the Lord for His gracious provision through your sacrificial giving during these difficult times. For the first three months of 2020, we are operating at a small deficit of \$15,113.

As we continue to trust the Lord to provide for us in this new normal, the Consistory in its stewardship is committed to keep our staff employed during this pandemic, while we embrace a certain resilience and practicality. More importantly, the Consistory has adopted the recommendation of our Finance Team, revising the 2020 Budget from \$876k to \$600K. This adjustment mainly comes from: deferring previously planned capital expenditures from 2020 to 2021 (except for essential repairs), and rescheduling all short-term mission projects until the health authorities have given the green light for international travel to resume; reducing the cost of facility upkeep resulting from the suspension of all church activities, and adapting the summer conferences to more appropriate venues.
