Conference Rules

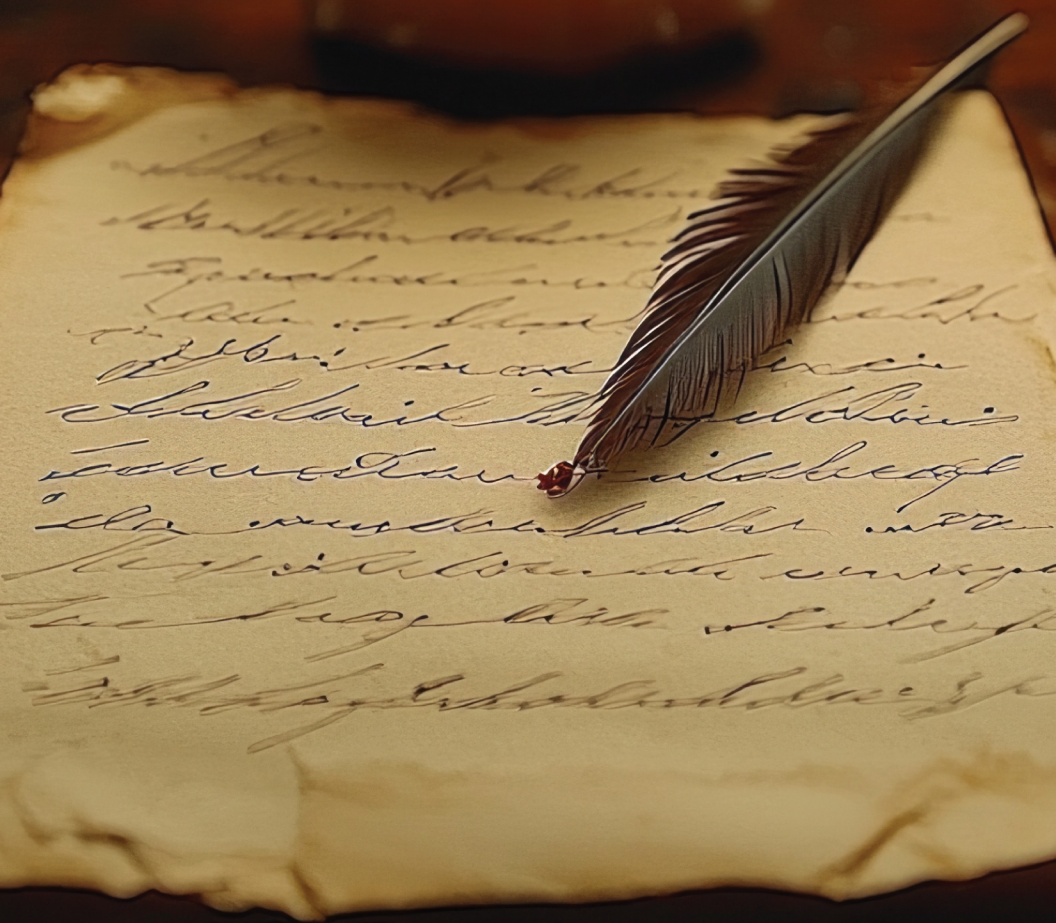

Scriptural Truth:

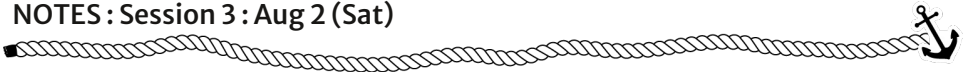
God guides His crew members with his word.

Application:

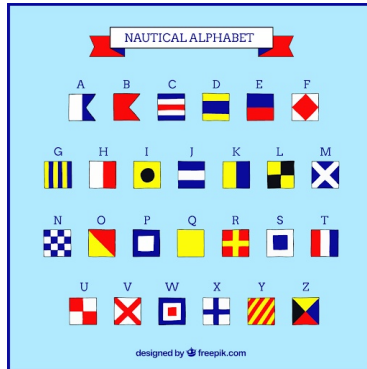
Use whatever abilities you have to serve God and people.
