Scripture Verses & Notes January 25th, 2026

“For His Love Endures Forever”

Psalm 107:1–3, 23–32 & 43

- 1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.
- 2 Let the redeemed of the LORD tell their story— those he redeemed from the hand of the foe, 3 those he gathered from the lands, from east and west, from north and south.[a]

- 23 Some went out on the sea in ships; they were merchants on the mighty waters.
- 24 They saw the works of the LORD, his wonderful deeds in the deep.
- 25 For he spoke and stirred up a tempest that lifted high the waves.
- 26 They mounted up to the heavens and went down to the depths; in their peril their courage melted away.
- 27 They reeled and staggered like drunkards; they were at their wits' end.
- 28 Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and he brought them out of their distress.
- 29 He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea[a] were hushed.
- 30 They were glad when it grew calm, and he guided them to their desired haven.
- 31 Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind.
- 32 Let them exalt him in the assembly of the people and praise him in the council of the elders.

- 43 Let the one who is wise heed these things and ponder the loving deeds of the LORD.

Do you know why we should receive Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior? And how to?

What the Bible says:

GOD LOVES YOU and offer a wonderful plan for your life “For God so love the world that He gave His only Son, that **whosoever believes in Him** shall not perish, but have eternal life” (John 3:16); (Jesus said) “I came that they might have life, and might have it abundantly” (John 10:10)

SIN HAS SEPARATED US from God! “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD” (Romans 3:23); “For the wages of sin is death”(Romans 6:23)

JESUS CHRIST is GOD'S Only PROVISION FOR MAN'S SIN; HE DIED IN YOUR PLACE. “But God demonstrates His own love towards us, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**” (Romans 5:8); **HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD.** “Christ died for our sins...He was buried...He was raised on the third day, according to the Scriptures...He appeared to Peter, then to the TWELVE. After that He appeared to more than five hundred...” (1 Corinthians 15:3–6);

JESUS is the ONLY WAY to GOD!

“**Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way the truth and the life; no one** comes to the father, but through **Me**”(John 14:6)

WE MUST INDIVIDUALLY RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST AS SAVIOR AND LORD; then we can know and experience GOD's love and plan for our lives. **WE MUST RECEIVE CHRIST** “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name” (John1:12) **WE RECEIVE CHRIST THROUGH FAITH** “For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast” (Ephesians 2:8,9) **WE RECEIVE CHRIST BY PERSONAL INVITATION** (Jesus said) “Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him” (Revelation 3:20);

YOU CAN RECEIVE CHRIST RIGHT NOW BY FAITH THROUGH PRAYER.
